

Night to Shine Frequently Asked Questions

What activities are provided at the Virtual Night to Shine on February 12th?

- The virtual experience will NOT be a giant Zoom call or a webcam of a prom somewhere, but rather will be an exciting program designed specifically for the honored guests all viewed from the comfort and safety of their home! This program will contain 3-D animation, celebrity drop-ins, and music with words on the screen for those guests who want to sing and dance along karaoke-style. There will even be a virtual crowning! The Tim Tebow Foundation is specifically crafting this program to be interesting, exciting, stimulating, and fun for guests with special needs and their families. Trust me... you do not want to miss it!

When is the Virtual Night to Shine event?

- Friday, February 12, 2021 from 6:00-7:00 pm (EST)

Where and how do I access the Virtual Night to Shine?

- Closer to February 12, 2021 Crosspoint will provide you with a link to the virtual experience. All you will need to do to access the event is click the link! There will be no need to download software or register for an account. The Virtual Night to Shine will be experienced from the comfort of your own home.

When is the Shine Thru event?

- Friday, February 5, 2021 from 6:00-8:30 pm (EST). Closer to February 6, 2021, you will receive an appointment time from Crosspoint. The appointment time will be sometime between 6-8 pm (EST) and will be for a 45 minute time slot.

Where is the Shine Thru event hosted?

- The 2021 Shine Thru event will be in person at Crosspoint Church 204 SW 11th Place, Cape Coral, FL 33991.

What should I expect at the Shine Thru?

- The Shine Thru is a drive thru jamboree celebrating the honored guests. This event is in person and will be enjoyed from the safety and comfort of your car. There will be a drive by red carpet entrance, hundreds of lights,

a car photo booth, entertainment, karaoke and much more. This is also where you will receive the gift bags and the honored guest's crown/Tierra.

What precautionary measures will be taken at the Shine Thru Event?

- All volunteers will be wearing masks. All volunteers that will be passing out gift bags or treats will also be wearing gloves.

Do I have to attend both the Night to Shine Virtual Experience and the Shine Thru Experience?

- It is not required to attend both experiences. The Shine Thru is an additional experience Crosspoint is providing to celebrate the honored guests beyond the virtual experience. There will be a red carpet, lite archways, entertainment, music, goodie bags, and most importantly a bunch of volunteers ready to celebrate the honored guests.

Who can attend the Night to Shine events?

- Night to Shine is open to anyone with physical and cognitive special needs, ages 14 and older.

When will I be able to register to attend Night to Shine 2021?

- Registration, for both the Shine Thru and the VIRTUAL Night to Shine, will open on December 6, 2020.

What should I wear?

- Even though Night to Shine will be a drive thru and virtual experience, we still encourage you to dress up if you would like to! If you do dress up, be sure to send us a picture of your outfit!
